



The Joan Hickey Kelly Memorial Fund

This memorial scholarship fund was created to honor Episcopal Deacon Joan Hickey Kelly, a native of Harford County, a member of Holy Trinity Episcopal Church in Churchville, Deacon at Emmanuel Episcopal Church in Bel Air, and a former teacher in Harford County Public Schools.

Joan was a trusted companion and friend to many who will be remembered for her infectious smile and laughter. A tireless, energetic leader, Joan, was an advocate for people of all ages.

Instrumental in establishing numerous outreach and fellowship activities, Joan organized the first summer reading camp at Emmanuel Church in Bel Air in 2017. She arranged summer camps for youth, provided backpacks for students in need, organized events such as the Holy Trinity Scrapbookers, and a yearly Quarter Auction. She also worked on creating manna bags for the homeless and volunteered in a variety of county functions.

Archdeacon Jane O'Leary remembered her by stating, "Joan truly brought the needs of the world to the Church and the Church to the world."

Joan's legacy will live on in this memorial scholarship fund that Holy Trinity is proud to establish.
